- Participant eligibility: Undergraduate or graduate student in soil science as of June, 2014
- Team composition: A coach and four students
- No. of teams per country: Up to 2 teams per country
- Entrance fee: free
- Registration: All the participating students must register for 20WCSS as students (registration fee: \$350)
- 10. Travel scholarship: \$1,000/team (will be paid at registration)
- 11. Awards: individual, team, overall
- 12. Contest handbook: Can download on the web-site.
