Mr. Achouri, a national of Tunisia, is a specialist in soil and water conservation as well as in watershed management sciences, with a broad coverage of technical and socio-economic related sciences and disciplines. He started his professional career in 1982 in the Forestry Department of the Ministry of Agriculture in Tunisia. His experience with International Organizations started in 1988 when he served for FAO/UNDP as National Chief Technical Advisor. He joined FAO in 1995 and since then has worked in Pakistan, Yemen, Syria, Egypt and Italy. Before joining the Land and Water Division he served in Cairo as Deputy Regional Representative for the Near East and as Head of the Multi-disciplinary Team for Oriental Near East and FAO Representative in Egypt. Throughout his career he was instrumental in establishing and enhancing a broad range of partnerships, in house and outside, and successful in bringing in the financial support of many donors. Mr. Achouri holds a B.Sc. in Rural Engineering and Soil and Water Conservation from the Institut National Agronomique de Tunis, Tunisia, and an M.Sc. in Watershed Management Sciences from Utah State University, USA.
